#### **Status of publication of assessment results**

The 2021 Assessment Results/Marks for all faculties have now been captured and published. The Academic Administration Offices are currently busy with validations and progressions in preparation for the upcoming registrations. All enquiries relating to the publication of marks should be addressed to relevant Administrative Assistants as per the attached list.

#### **2022 First Cycle Registration Dates**

Kindly note the following amendments to the approved Academic Calendar for 2022 impacting on Student Registrations. These revised dates have been necessitated by the announcement of the DBE matric results date. The revised dates are as follows:

- First-year registrations for all faculties commence on 24 January 2022 and end on 29 January 2022;
- Returning student registrations for all faculties will commence on 27 January 2022 and will end on 5 February 2022;
- Classes will commence on 7 February 2022.

Should there be any change to this schedule, information will be communicated timely. All registration queries should be directed as per the attached list of officials.

#### **Academic Records**

All students requiring academic records should contact the relevant officials as per the attached list.

Kindly note that the office of Mr Mofokeng is currently finalising the online academic records process, which will go live by the end of February 2022.
