Financial Sustainability & Governance – Enhancing financial management, securing strategic industry partnerships, and boosting third-stream income.

Community & Industry Engagement – Strengthening ties with industry giants like Sasol, South32 and ArcelorMittal and expanding global academic collaborations.

Prof Ndlovu emphasised the role of faculty, students, alumni, and partners in shaping VUT's future. "We must work together to create a university that not only keeps pace with global trends but actively shapes the future of higher education, industry, and society," he said.
