- 3. Certified copies of all qualifications.
- 4. Certified copy of ID
- 5. Current contact information of referees

Nominations must reach the Registrar's Office no later than **Friday, 18 July 2025**. A Council member thus appointed will serve on the Council in his or her personal capacity and not as a representative of any interest group.
