Short Learning Programme: Medical cannabis

This course explores indoor and outdoor Cannabis cultivation techniques for the small-scale growers. Topics covered include botany, the cannabis growth cycle, growing systems and media, nutrients, environmental controls such as lighting, media, ventilation, etc., strain selection, and sanitation/disease/pest control. Students will learn the fundamental botany and cultivation methods within a controlled environment, as well as processing techniques required for optimal production and yield. The students will also study a range of topics, including, botany and genetics of the cannabis plant, seeds, germination, cloning, light sources, pests, disease.

Who Should attend

The school leavers with at least Grade 10 (South African DBE system or equivalent). Students without Grade 10, but with practical experience on farms, are also encouraged to apply and may be granted entry through Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Applicants must be over 18 years old.
