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VUT announces the 2026/27 SRC Executive Committee

Vaal University of Technology (VUT) is pleased to announce the final composition of the Student Representative Council (SRC) Executive Committee for the 2026/27 term.

The Executive Committee was formally constituted during the inaugural meeting of the SRC, held online on 15 September 2026. The Independent Electoral Commission (IEC) has confirmed that the constituting process was conducted in accordance with the SRC Constitution.

In terms of clause 9.1 of the Constitution, the President and Secretary-General portfolios were allocated to the South African Students Congress (SASCO), which received the highest number of votes and secured more than the required two-seat threshold. The remaining portfolios were filled unopposed after each nominee received the required minimum number of nominations and formally accepted their nomination.
